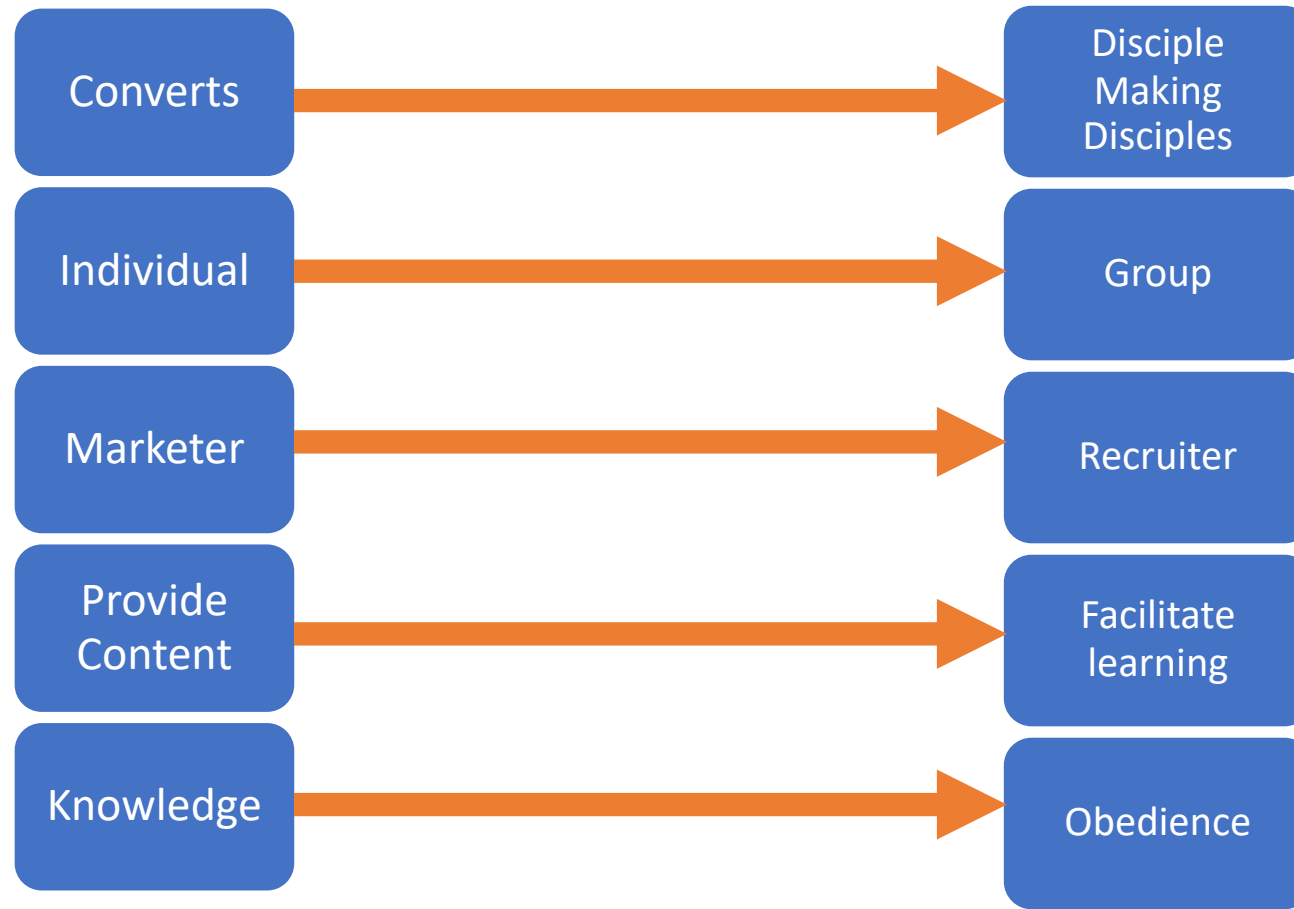

Goal Setting and Review

- At least one disciple in one year
- Present the gospel or testimony once a month or **do a DBS**
- Have meaningful connection (dinner, coffee, gardening etc 2 times a month)
- Have a casual 5-10 mins conversation (once a week)
- Have any type of connection with a neighbor 3 times a week.
- Get names and phone numbers of 10 – 20 neighbors and co-workers within 6 months
- **Go out among the lost for 1hr every week.**
- **Pray a lot for the lost (1-1-3)**

Levels of Conversations (Paul Watson)

- Casual
- Meaningful
- Spiritual
- Discovery





Casual Conversation

- High level.
- Anyone can participate in this
- It is about general (not personal) topics
- Most of the information exchange is common knowledge



Examples of Casual Conversations

- Hi, How are you doing?
- What are you doing this weekend?
- Hoe do you keep your lawn so healthy?

Meaningful Conversation

- More personal
- It requires some level of vulnerability
- The topics of discussion means a lot to the person.
- They usually come up after casual conversations.
- Many times they are responses to questions.





Examples of Meaningful conversations

- I'm having a surgery next week.
- I have not seen my children for 6 years
- My dog just died.

Some responses

- So how long have you had this dog that died? What was its name?
- Really? What type of surgery?
- I had a surgery last year.

Spiritual Conversations

- You respond to meaningful conversations with a testimony with a spiritual component.
- You offer to pray about a problem.
- You ask about spiritual belief and listen.





Examples of spiritual conversations

- Hmm.. you know when I am stressed I pray. And God really answers prayers.
- I would be happy to pray for you. Can we pray right now?
- What are your thoughts about life after death?

Discovery Conversations

- You respond to meaningful conversations with stories from the Bible.
- You let the other person respond to the Bible story you shared.





Examples of Discovery conversations

- What you said about your son reminds me of a story in the Bible about two sons. The father asked both of them to do some work for him....
- There is a story in the Bible about a man who was attacked by robbers and he was helped by a person that did not look religious.

Tips

- You should aim at listening 80% of the time in all conversations You should aim at listening 80% of the time in all conversations.
- There would be a need to invest time into relationships with lots of prayers.
- Don't worry about how long it takes but keep your calendar open to God.





Tips contd.

- Remember that you only invest more when you sense a spiritual hunger after making initial investments.
- Remember to applaud progress and refrain from teaching extensively. Instead facilitate learning.
- Aim for groups. Pray for groups and ask for groups when the time is right.
